General Attributes:

Fresh in appearance. Shape and colour must be true to variety. Heads (flower clusters) to be well formed, firm and compact. Unless trimmed, cauliflower should be sufficiently protected by outside leaves. Size to be consistent within crate.

Temperature:

Optimum storage temperature is 4°C.

Labelling:

All crates / cartons must be labelled with: OBJ

- Suppliers trading name.
- Suppliers trading address.
- Pack date.
- Product name and/or Article Description
- Variety
- Count
- Grade
- Shipper Barcode
- GAP Number and GAP Name

Crates and Bins:

If product is supplied in a Bin or Crate, bin and crate must be collapsible (unless otherwise stated) and be from an approved supplier.


Defect List:

Unacceptable (0% tolerance)

• Bruising or mechanical and physical damage. Foreign smells or taste. Pest/disease related residue or damage on head. Soiling. Soft yellowing Florets. Dehydrated product. Freezer damage

Major (5% tolerance)

• Insect / mechanical or disease damage on outer leaves.
